

ICED17 Young Members Event (YME) Design in 2030 – The Future of Design Tuesday, August 22nd, 18:45-20:30 EXTENDED DEADLINE JUNE 23

The Young Members Event at ICED will now be performed for the third time and we invite young members to attend and present their views on the future of design.

The aim of the current event is to:

- Discuss grand design challenges that humans face and that need to be addressed until 2030.
- Explore potential ways of addressing these grand challenges through design research and practice
- Meet young professionals in design research, practice and entrepreneurship

FORMAT

Speakers are invited to present a dynamic, short talk (5 min) with the help of multimedia (e.g. video, images, etc) regarding a **grand design challenge in the intersection of their work and the theme of the conference – resource-sensitive design**.

In sharing their vision, speakers should include the following elements in their talk:

- **What** is a grand design challenge that you think needs to be addressed until 2030?
- **Why** is it important that this challenge is addressed?
- **Who** would you ask to participate in this design challenge?
- **How** would you incentivize their participation?

NOTE TO SPEAKERS

This presentation does not necessarily have to correspond to your current or past research projects or work. It is open to allow you to present new ideas, directions and hurdles that need to be overcome to achieve your future vision of design research and practice for life.

PARTICIPANTS

Participants of the ICED17 conference and the local design, engineering and business community are invited to apply to speak at this event. Masters and PhD students, post-doctoral fellows and other young professions who have graduated recently are invited to apply.

PROCESS

Application

To present in this event make sure to apply by **June 23** via the application form <https://goo.gl/forms/AomoFqFaF4yzqchK2>. The application needs to include the title, a brief description and a **2-min video summary of your talk**.

Selection

The Young Members organisers will select up to 10 people to present and the applicants will be notified by email of the talk acceptance before **June 30th**.

Draft presentation

The selected presenters will after the notification of acceptance send a video of the draft presentation to the event committee by **August 1st**. The event committee will review the presentation and provide feedback for the final presentation on ICED.

The event at ICED

The Young Members event will be a high paced event where new ideas and visions will be presented and all participants have the opportunity to network and collaborate together and create a vision for the future.

DESIGN SCIENCE JOURNAL SPECIAL ARTICLE INVITATIONAL

Design in 2030 – A young researchers' vision of the future

The Design Science Journal (DSJ) will publish a special invited contribution in a collection of select presentations derived from the Young Members Event.

A selection committee will issue the invitations following the event on Tuesday, August 22, 2017. The selected presenters will be invited to submit a short text along with a multimedia presentation for the usual DSJ review process. The collection will be published along with the associated multimedia files as a single article in DSJ, similar to an editorial. DSJ will also issue certificates of recognition to all selected authors and the article will be highlighted at the journal website.
